**Easter Devotional: “Because He Lives”**



**Reflection:** Easter is the celebration of hope fulfilled. The cross showed us the depth of God’s love, but the empty tomb shows us His power. Jesus’ resurrection reminds us that no situation is beyond God’s ability to redeem—whether it’s fear, grief, failure, or uncertainty.

The disciples came to the tomb expecting an ending, but God met them with a beginning. In the same way, Easter invites us to trust that God is still working, even when things feel final or broken. Because Jesus lives, we are never without hope, purpose, or new life.

**Prayer:** Lord, thank You for the miracle of Easter. Thank You that the grave was not the end and that Your resurrection brings hope into our lives today. Help us to live with resurrection faith—bold, trusting, and full of joy. Amen.

**Takeaway Thought:** Because He lives, hope is alive, forgiveness is real, and new beginnings are always possible.

## Cabin & Campsite Matters

### **Certificate of Insurance:**

Cabin Owners - Cabin leaseholders are reminded that your Certificate of Insurance with \$2,000,000 general liability coverage was due February 15th, 2026. Thank you to those cabin leaseholders who have already submitted their COI, or contacted us to keep us informed of their process of obtaining your COI. Please note this is an annual requirement, as per the direction of our insurance provider.

The office kindly asks everyone to review your renewal date, as many certificates submitted in 2025 have now expired.

### **Gate Code for Guests:**

Gate codes have been created for camp guests who are staying in a leaseholder's cabin or RV. Please **DO NOT** give out your personal PIN code, instead contact the office for a separate code.

### **Payments:**

For any payments, such as Cabin Taxes, RV Fees, services or other payments, we have auto deposit for our accounts to allow a smooth payment process. For E-Transfer payments, you can use [payments@sunsetpointcamp.ca](mailto:payments@sunsetpointcamp.ca) Please be sure to specify what your E-transfer is for, to aid our staff and Accountant to apply the funds as required (e.g. Invoice No. for Cabin Taxes, Donation, Designated Donation, etc.).

### **Annual/Partial Annual RV Site Renewals & Availability:**

Please note that all RV contracts now have a renewal date of May 1st. The renewal notice has been sent out. Please contact the Camp Administrator if you have not received your notice. The Camp currently has two full-service sites available for an annual rental.
