Scripture:

Camp Winter Report

Although we are still early in the New Year, Camp remains very busy as work continues to enhance our facilities and amenities.

Our housekeeping team has almost completed the annual deep cleaning of Elim Lodge and the Christian Center. This thorough cleaning is an important part of maintaining our facilities and ensuring they are well prepared for the busy season ahead.

The maintenance team has also been hard at work with snow removal, painting the Christian Center washrooms, coordinating with contractors on various projects, and completing many preventative maintenance tasks. In addition, a new fire panel has been installed in the Christian Center lobby to bring the system into compliance with current industry standards.

Administration has been busy connecting with rental groups, preparing estimates, updating forms for the annual RV renewals, and beginning preparations for Family Camp 2026. We have also been working with our cabin and RV owners to collect the required annual Certificate of Insurance. The office kindly asks everyone to review your renewal date, as many certificates submitted in 2025 have now expired. All cabin and RV owners are asked to submit their updated Certificate of Insurance to the office no later than February 15 by emailing info@sunsetpointcamp.ca.

In January, we shared a need for additional chairs and dollies for the Children's Tabernacle and Elim Lodge. We are very grateful to report that, through the generosity and partnership of two families, all remaining chairs and dollies needed for these spaces have been purchased and are now on site. The Camp sincerely thanks those who supported this initiative.

In February, the annual fire inspection and Alberta Health inspections will take place to ensure all buildings and systems are fully compliant for the upcoming year.

Cabin & Campsite Matters

Certificate of Insurance:

Cabin Owners - Cabin leaseholders are reminded that your Certificate of Insurance is due no later than February 15th, 2026. Thank you to those cabin leaseholders who have already submitted their COI. Please note this is an annual requirement, as per the direction of our insurance provider.

Gate Code for Guests:

Gate codes have been created for camp guests who are staying in a leaseholder's cabin or RV. Please **DO NOT** give out your personal PIN code, instead contact the office for a separate code.

Payments:

For any payments, such as Cabin Taxes, RV Fees, services or other payments, we have auto deposit for our accounts to allow a smooth payment process. For E-Transfer payments, you can use payments@sunsetpointcamp.ca Please be sure to specify what your E-transfer is for, to aid our staff and Accountant to apply the funds as required (e.g. Invoice No. for Cabin Taxes, Donation, Designated Donation, etc.).

Family Camp 2026:

Please note that Family Camp for 2026 will run from Saturday, June 27, to Sunday, July 5.

Annual/Partial Annual RV Site Renewals:

Please note that all RV contracts now have a renewal date of May 1st. In March/April, Camp Administration will be sending out renewal contracts for completion. Once the office receives the completed contract, an invoice for payment will be emailed to you. Payment is required by May 1st, 2026. Please contact the office for any questions you may have.

Certificate of Insurance:

The office has been working with our cabin and RV owners to collect the required **ANNUAL** Certificate of Insurance with \$2,000,000 general liability coverage. The office kindly asks everyone to review your renewal date, as many certificates submitted in 2025 have now expired. All cabin and RV owners are asked to submit their updated Certificate of Insurance to the office no later than February 15 by emailing info@sunsetpointcamp.ca.
