**Spring Devotional: “New Life in Bloom”**



Spring has a way of reminding us that God is always at work—often quietly, gently, and long before we see the results. After a long winter, the ground that once seemed frozen and lifeless suddenly bursts with color. Buds appear. Birds return. Light lingers just a little longer each evening.

In Scripture, God often uses the imagery of growth and renewal to describe the way He works in our hearts: “See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?” — Isaiah 43:19 (NIV)

Just as the earth begins to thaw and awaken, God is continually cultivating new things within us—fresh hope, deeper trust, renewed strength, and a clearer sense of His presence. Even when we go through seasons that feel cold, quiet, or slow, He is still preparing something beautiful beneath the surface.

Spring invites us to pause and notice the small signs of God’s faithfulness:

- A prayer answered in an unexpected way
- Peace settling where worry once lived
- Joy blooming after a season of heaviness
- Strength rising where we once felt weak

These are the spiritual “buds” of new life—reminders that God is growing something good.

## Cabin & Campsite Matters

### **Certificate of Insurance:**

Cabin Owners - Cabin leaseholders are reminded that your Certificate of Insurance with \$2,000,000 general liability coverage was due February 15th, 2026. Thank you to those cabin leaseholders who have already

submitted their COI, or contacted us to keep us informed of their process of obtaining your COI. Please note this is an annual requirement, as per the direction of our insurance provider.

The office kindly asks everyone to review your renewal date, as many certificates submitted in 2025 have now expired.

**Gate Code for Guests:**

Gate codes have been created for camp guests who are staying in a leaseholder's cabin or RV. Please **DO NOT** give out your personal PIN code, instead contact the office for a separate code.

**Payments:**

For any payments, such as Cabin Taxes, RV Fees, services or other payments, we have auto deposit for our accounts to allow a smooth payment process. For E-Transfer payments, you can use [payments@sunsetpointcamp.ca](mailto:payments@sunsetpointcamp.ca) Please be sure to specify what your E-transfer is for, to aid our staff and Accountant to apply the funds as required (e.g. Invoice No. for Cabin Taxes, Donation, Designated Donation, etc.).

Please note that the 2025 Cabin Tax & Fees Notices will be mailed out in June. Please watch your email, Junk and SPAM folders to ensure you receive your notice.

**Annual/Partial Annual RV Site Renewals:**

Please note that all RV contracts now have a renewal date of May 1st. The renewal notice has been sent out. Please contact the Camp Administrator if you have not received your notice. Once the office receives the completed contract, an invoice for payment will be emailed to you. Payment is required by April 30th, 2026. Please contact the office for any questions you may have.

## Winter Maintenance Spotlight



Did you know? Red lights in windows during winter, act as a low-temperature alert system to prevent frozen pipes and home damage. When the interior temperature drops below a set, unsafe level, the light activates, allowing neighbors to see the alert from outside and notify you.

Why Use Red Lights for Winter Safety:

- Remote Monitoring: It provides a simple, visible, and, non-connected way for neighbors to check on your cabin while you are away, far easier than monitoring a traditional, hidden thermometer.
- Preventing Frozen Pipes: The primary purpose is to warn of a furnace failure, allowing for quick, intervention before water pipes freeze and burst, which can cause catastrophic damage.
- Power Failure Detection: If connected to a backup source, these lights can alert you to, power outages that have shut down your heating system.
- Visual Alert System: The bright red light is designed to be easily seen from the street, even during the day, ensuring the problem is noticed quickly.

In addition to installing a red light, Cabin leaseholders may also look at the option of installing a digital thermostat in your cabin so you can monitor your cabin using an app on your phone. This will alert you to any changes in your cabin temperature, so you can respond accordingly.
