

Summer Happenings

The Camp has had a very busy, yet wonderful summer camp season, and we are excited to head into the fall season. Over the course of the summer, the Camp hosted seventeen groups, including the July Family Camp, and SonRise Camp. Camp staff are working hard to prepare for the final few months of the Camp season, and 2025.

Did you know that the Camp hosts groups from January through to November, with an average of 60-65 groups per year? The ministry that takes throughout the camp season is incredible with 135 water baptisms taking place, so far in 2025.

The "slower" months of December to March, provide an opportunity for camp staff to do a deep clean of the Christian Center, Elim Lodge, and the other facilities. This is done annually, and gives us an opportunity to give each building a refresh.

As the Camp continues to grow and thrive, Camp staff continue to work hard to make necessary repairs and upgrades to serve you better. This includes, repairs to the water and boiler systems, repairs and maintenance on essential kitchen equipment and camp equipment, and the electrical upgrades that are currently underway.

One more significant upgrade that is taking place is in the Putt Putt Mini Golf Park. While we recognize that people are missing this amenity, it was necessary to close the park to complete essential repairs and maintenance. The remainder of the repairs are expected to take place over the fall and into the winter. This includes shed repairs, siding and new signage.

The re-opening is expected to take place during the Spring of 2026. Thank you to everyone for your patience, while the upgrades are taking place. The Camp would also like to extend a huge thank you to the volunteers who have undertaken to oversee and do the essential repairs on this project, and for the donations that have been received towards this work.



Certificate of Insurance:

Please note that all Certificates of Insurance for Cabin Leaseholders were due by June 30th and are now overdue. If you have not yet submitted your COI, please provide it promptly to the office to bring your file into compliance. You may email your document to info@sunsetpointcamp.ca Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Please note that the Certificate of Insurance is an annual requirement to keep your file up to date.

Gate Code for Guests:

Take note, gate codes have been created for camp guests who are staying in a leaseholder's cabin or RV. Please **DO NOT** give out your personal PIN code, instead please contact the office for a separate code.

Payments:

For any payments, such as Cabin Taxes, RV Fees, services or other payments, we now have auto deposit for our accounts to allow a smooth payment process. For payments please use payments@sunsetpointcamp.ca Please be sure to specify what your E-transfer is for to aid our staff and Accountant to apply the funds as required. (E.g. Invoice No. for Cabin Taxes, Donation, Designated Donation etc.)

Camp Policies:

Community Shed:

With the fall season approaching, we recognize that cabin leaseholders and RV owners may have some small repairs to complete. Please note there is a community shed on site that has a variety of tools, etc. available for your use. We simply ask that you return the item to the shed for the benefit of other individuals to use. The Community Shed is located next to the main washrooms south east of the managers residence. Please ensure to doors closed when you are finished.

Camp Dumpsters & Burn Pit:

Please note that the Camp's dumpsters are for household garbage ONLY. Individuals who do not adhere to these procedures will be invoiced for costs to remove the items and any subsequent disposal fees. The burn pit area is for wood only. Organics such as grass clippings, leaves, etc. can be placed in the respective areas as indicated by the signage in the burn pit.
