



Off Highway Vehicle Specific Rules

To accommodate a full range of campers and guests, everyone at Sunset Point Camp must obey and respect the following rules:

1. Off Highway Vehicles (OHV) vehicles that fall under this category are ATVs, quads, motorbikes etc.
2. The owner of an OHV must register at the camp office and agree to and follow these rules.
3. Every person operating or riding an OHV must sign a Release, agree to and follow these rules.
4. Every OHV must have an approval tag which is easily visible on it.
5. Anyone under 18 years old on an OHV is required to wear an approved safety helmet.
6. During camp rentals, recreational driving is restricted to the back trail areas only (far east side of property). The OHV may only be driven through the camp for the purpose of getting directly to or from the trails. Keep daily commuting to a minimum.
7. During the APMS Camp no recreational driving is permitted on the entire camp property.
8. Always follow the posted speed limits and drive in a safe and courteous manner.
9. If a person rides an OHV off our property on public land adjacent to ours they must also follow the applicable bylaws.
10. We encourage all users to consider others and not abuse this privilege.
11. If you see someone is not following these rules please inform them of the rules. If they still do not comply contact the camp caretaker or any officer of the camp board.
