## **PENTECOSTALISM**

The charismatic movement find its roots in Pentecostalism and its teaching about the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

- A belief in a first work of grace in conversion and second work of grace in the baptism of the Holy Spirit that completes sanctification. A movement called "perfectionism."
- Different views on the level of sanctification and the work of God's spirit exist in this movement.
- Often linked with a speaking in tongues.
- Creates a separation between Christians who do and do not speak in tongues.
