The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

What is the purpose of the Spiritual gifts? For the common good of the body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:7) to build up the church (1 Cor. 14:12) for works of service that we might be united in faith and knowledge of God, reaching the maturity of fullness in Christ (Eph. 4:12–13).

SPIRITUAL GIFTS

•	Every believer receives the Holy Spirit as a seal of salvation	Eph. 1:12-14
•	The Spirit gives each believer gifts to do the work of God	1 Cor. 12:4-6
•	The purpose of spiritual gifts is to promote "the common good" of the body of Christ	1 Cor. 12:7
•	to build up the church	1 Cor. 14:12
•	and to prepare us each for works of service.	Eph. 4:12–13
•	The temptation of spiritual gifts is to use them to draw attention to ourselves.	1 Cor. 14:4
•	This is a particular problem with the gift of languages because it can be faked.	1 Cor. 14:23

PAUL'S TEACHING TO THE CORINTHIANS

•	Spiritual gifts are a reality that Paul wants the church to understand.	1 Cor. 12:1
•	Spiritual gifts are varied because the service to God is varied, but one Spirit.	1 Cor. 12:4-11

A DIVERSITY OF GIFTS

- God is both one and three. Like one body has many members so too with the church. 1 Cor. 12:12-13
- The Spirit empowers all member of the church for ministry. Priesthood of all believers.

 1 Peter 2:9
 - The church is not restricted to a few professionals.

ONE BODY

- Jesus has a specific task for each church member, and each is equipped for that role. 1 Cor. 12:14-19
 - o Reductio ad absurdum taken to its logical conclusion
 - o To favour one gift reduces the church to have only one ability at the expense of others.
- To each is given a gift so that the church functions properly. 1 Cor. 12:27-30

THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

•	There are higher gifts to strive for	1 Cor. 12:31
•	Love needs to be the foundation of all gifts	1 Cor. 13:1
•	Love does not end as other gifts will.	1 Cor. 13:8-10
•	But that does not mean they are unimportant.	1 Cor. 14:1

THE GIFT OF TONGUES

•	There is no profit to the church if we speak a language not understood	1 Cor. 14:2-6
•	We must be wary we are not faking it and babbling like pagans	Matt. 6:7

God is a God of order and clarity for the building up of the church not the puffing up of the believer in a false sense of super-spiritual superiority.
