

# Accelerant 2022 - Gatlinburg, TN

## Informational Letter

### DATES

### COST

- Students:
  - \$165 - Regular attending Redland Students and/or Redland Church attenders

### DEADLINES (*Please note there are multiple deadlines*)

*Sunday, November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021*

- First Payment due - \$95 registration fee (non-refundable)

*Sunday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022*

### PAYMENTS

- All forms of payment, whether check or cash, need to be earmarked "Accelerant 2022 Trip"
  - Write this on the check memo line or place cash in a marked envelope
  - Please include the name of the student(s) and/or leader on the envelope as well

### MEALS

- Students will be responsible for 5 meals. Their meal at the Old Mill on Friday will be taken care of by Redland Students. All other **meals should be around \$10-\$15 depending on how they order**. Our meals Thursday and Sunday will be fast food due to travel.
- Students need to bring approximately \$75 or more to cover their meals. Again, this amount is largely determined by how your student chooses to order and where they choose to eat. (*or how many Starbucks coffee/drinks they consume ☺*)
- A continental breakfast is provided by the hotel. If your child wants a specific breakfast food, they will need to bring that with them.

### DRESS CODE

- Dress is casual for the trip including services. Students are welcome to wear jeans and sweatshirts the entire weekend as weather permits.
- Please check weather report for Gatlinburg before packing, as students may want short sleeves during the day and warmer clothing for the evening.

### SPENDING MONEY

- Students will be responsible for any spending money in addition to meal money. Students will have the opportunity to shop on Saturday and other times, as they are available.

### WHAT TO BRING

- Comfortable shoes as we will be doing a lot of walking
- Coat/jacket and possibly a hat if temps are really cold
- Money (meals & spending)
- Pillow or blanket for travel and room
- Backpack or cinch sac to carry throughout each day.  
*(Please note that backpacks/cinch sacs will not be allowed inside the service venue this year)*
- Small umbrella as needed
- *In terms of COVID-19, we are not requiring masks on this trip, however, there may be certain establishments that we visit that may require them. So, each student and leader is encouraged to bring a mask just in case.*

### BEHAVIOR

- Students will represent Jesus, Redland Church and their families with character and integrity. We expect our students to handle themselves as they should and treat one another with respect. Any other behavior contrary to this is unacceptable.
