WOMEN'S KAIROS MINISTRY

Our Mission offering focus for the month of February is the Women's Kairos Ministry. You probably know that Forest Hills supports the Men's Kairos Ministry at Baldwin State Prison with cards, cookies, drinks and prayers - you may well have provided these things. But there is also a Women's Kairos Ministry at the Pulaski State Prison for Women. Their mission is the same - to bring the transforming love and forgiveness of Jesus to change hearts and lives. At the Women's Prison in Hawkinsville, the Kairos program is presented by women who volunteer to lead 3 1/2 day weekends to work on building the Christian Community inside the institution. This is followed by participants gathering regularly for accountability, support, and prayer.

Prison is a dark place and prisoners often have lost hope. Kairos brings the light, love and friendship of Jesus into their lives. They know they are forgiven and loved. For February we can send a Valentine of sorts to the women at Pulaski Prison by our offerings (Sunday School or designated) on Sunday mornings. The women are deeply touched to discover that people outside willingly donate money that sponsors the Kairos weekends.
