April 29, 2019	<i>My Name is Mahtob</i> by Mahtob Mahmoody		Mahtob is the daughter at the center of the international bestseller <i>Not Without My Daughter</i> . Mahtob's book completes the story. She chronicles her imprisonment and escape from Tehran as a six-year-old child. Her childhood in the USA was filled with fear of re-abduction and she endured recurring nightmares and panic attacks. She attended school under a false name while battling a life-threatening illness—all under the menacing shadow of her father.
