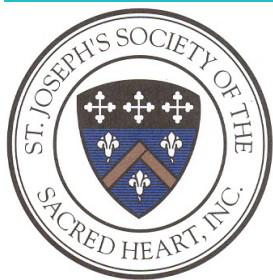

Celebrating the Centennial Year of Life: Blessed Mary Catherine Irigoyen 1918-2018

Sister Mary Catherine was born in Pamplona, Spain, in 1848. After meeting Sister Maria Soledad, she entered the order on December 31, 1881, and served the sick and dying throughout her life despite her own paralyzing

illness caused by tuberculosis of the bone. She died on October 10, 1918. Her cause of canonization was introduced by Pope John XXIII on February 14, 1962, and Pope Benedict XVI officially approved her beatification last April 2, 2011.

Sister Mary Catherine Irigoyen was beatified October 29, 2011 in Madrid. She is the second Sister Servant to be beatified. Sister Maria Soledad, who founded the Congregation of the Sisters Servants of Mary, Ministers to the Sick in 1851, was canonized in 1970.

Celebrando el Centenario de la Vida: Beata María Catalina Irigoyen 1918-2018

Sor María Catalina nació en Pamplona, España, en 1848. Después de conocer a Sor María Soledad, entró en la orden el 31 de diciembre de 1881, y sirvió a los enfermos y moribundos a lo largo de su vida a pesar de su propia enfermedad paralizante causada por la tuberculosis del hueso. Murió el 10 de octubre de 1918. Su causa de canonización fue introducida por el Papa Juan XXIII el 14 de febrero de 1962, y el Papa Benedicto XVI aprobó oficialmente su beatificación el pasado 2 de abril de 2011.

Sor María Catalina Irigoyen fue beatificada el 29 de octubre de 2011 en Madrid. Ella es la segunda hermana sierva para ser beatificada. La hermana María Soledad, que fundó la congregación de las hermanas Siervas de María, Ministra a los enfermos en 1851, fue canonizada en 1970.
