Greetings from Panama! We hope this update finds you all doing well! While we recognize that times have changed, we rest in this unchanging truth...Jesus still remains the same. That also means his work hasn't stopped or finished. Although we have had to make adjustments along the way, the kingdom of God is still strong and advancing.

Here are a couple of updates: We completed a new church building in Cerro Gato (cat hill) for an indigenous community. The name of the church is called Templo Betel (Bethel Church). Pastor Hernan, his wife and the church family were overwhelmed with gratitude and thanksgiving for this wonderful blessing. We also added another classroom for a new school we began last year for a church called "Bread of Life."

Paint Church received 19 new members, 9 believers baptized, 14 graduated from our school of discipleship and we had 180 people in our virtual life-groups. We passed out 120 gym towels and water bottles for our youth evangelistic outreach. Our current protocols here in Panama only allow for 50% of in-person attendance but the work has not stopped and the church is thriving.

Thank-you so much for your prayers and faithful support. We understand that for some, times have been really difficult but yet you continue to stand with us. Thank-you again because we couldn't do what we do without you!
