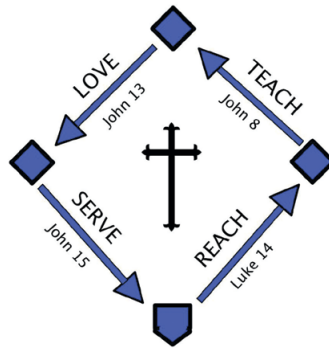

Pray for Open Doors

Col. 4:2-3

Heiko Burklin



Heiko Burklin - Heiko is the Mission Developer at World Witness. He has served as the senior pastor at the Neely's Creek ARP Church in Rock Hill, SC, (2009-2015), as the team leader for a youth church-planting team in East Berlin (1995-2006), and as the Minister of Youth and Christian Education at the First Presbyterian Church in Lake Wales, FL, (1986-1995). He has been married to his wife Kay since 1985. They have three sons, Stephan (married to Abigail), Yannick (married to Julia) and Micah (married to Laura). Heiko is a graduate of Taylor University (B.A. History) and Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary (M.Div. and D.Min.) and has worked with Samaritan's Purse and the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association.

Hendy Siu



Hendy Siu - Hendy was born in Vietnam into a Christian family. He became a Christian at the age of 11. Before 1975 his mother worked for the Red Cross in South Vietnam, and his father worked for the South Vietnamese government. On April 30, 1975, the North Vietnamese regime took over South Vietnam. After the take-over by the North Vietnamese regime, his father was imprisoned and was later assassinated by the Communist government. Hendy was baptized when he was 16 years of age and later graduated from high school in Vietnam at the age of 19. He came to the United States in 1994 and graduated with a BA from Toccoa Falls College in 1999. Hendy and his wife worked on Bible translation for Wycliffe Bible translators in Dallas, Texas. The Bible was published in the Vietnamese language in 2014. Hendy graduated with a Masters of Divinity from Criswell College in 2013. He and his family moved to Charlotte in 2015, where is pastoring Grace Montagnard Alliance Church.

Mike & Rebecca Navratil - Mike and Rebecca are members of Wycliffe Bible Translators, serving from the JAARS Center, where they work with the International Media Services (IMS). Mike does the department accounting, coordinates the purchase of equipment and supplies (primarily for the Waxhaw based department) and ships IMS products all over the world. In 2017 Rebecca completed quality checks on 30 Scripture videos (JESUS, GENESIS, Gospel of John, ACTS, LUKE, and Story of Genesis) that return to at least 12 countries (from Argentina to Vietnam). In July 2017 they spent 3 weeks in Brazil, dubbing a JESUS video in an indigenous language.

Sam Cotten - Sam and Martha Margaret Cotten became missionary candidates with World Witness in 2017. They will begin serving with the Mobile Theological Training Team (MT3), primarily in Africa. Their vision is to see pastors and church leaders established in Reformed teaching, in order to equip the church as it grows, particularly in its struggle with paganism and Islam. Sam has 12 years of pastoral experience in the U.S. With a BS from Erskine College and a Masters-Old Testament from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, he plans to pursue a Th.M. to further help him train future leaders. Martha Margaret has a BA in Social Studies from Erskine College and is pursuing a MA-Theological Studies from Erskine Seminary. The Cottens have four children: Joel -18, Andrew -16, Ethan - 14, and Gloria-Noelle -7.
