

**The Benefits of our Next Steps Kiosks**

Over the years, technology has changed. We have witnessed this with mail. We now have something called e-mail (instant electronic mail). We have also witnessed this evolution with the telephone that used to be attached to the wall in our home. Now, our phones are attached to our bodies. They are referred to as “smart phones” because they are like having a mini-computer in your hands. We also have iPhones, iPods and iPads. These are all beneficial in making things better!

With the redesign of our church foyer, we have added 4 new “Next Steps” Kiosks. If you are not familiar with the term ‘kiosk’, it’s nothing more than an iPad on a stand, mounted to a counter top. There are 4 of them located to the left in our foyer as you enter RBCC.

These kiosks are designed to assist you in taking Next Steps at Red Brush: You can join a Life Group or a Serving Team by using the kiosk. You can register and pay for a church event. You can purchase a church T-shirt by using the kiosk. You can enroll your kids in VBS. You can give your weekly tithe, mission gift or donate to a future building campaign, all by using the Kiosk.

Our Welcome Center Team is there to assist you in the use of these kiosks. Just look for someone with an “ASK ME” button and they’ll be glad to answer questions, guide you through the simple process, or even do it for you!

Statics reveal the younger generation does most of their banking online and are less apt to carry cash or a checkbook, therefore this will provide a giving option for these people. Here are some benefits to using the kiosks for your contributions to the church:

- ◆ The kiosks provide secure giving.
- ◆ 100% of your gift goes to Red Brush.
- ◆ You can give one time per week or you can set up recurring giving.
- ◆ All kiosks are equipped with privacy screens so that only you can see your gift.
- ◆ All of your donations are tracked for the year for your tax benefits.
- ◆ You are emailed a receipt for your gift immediately.

I’ll never forget when I was driving on a toll road in Melinda’s car. I suddenly realized I had no cash, and no easy pass for sure. I frantically searched my pockets and then I looked to the console of her car. Luckily, she saves change and there was enough to pay the toll!! Just like I was unprepared for the toll, some folks may come to church and find themselves unprepared to give. They may search their pockets when the plate is passed or flip through their wallet, but with no check or cash—they cannot participate in the offering. In this moment, it’s not about desire—it’s more about ability. With our new kiosks—we give everyone the ability!!


