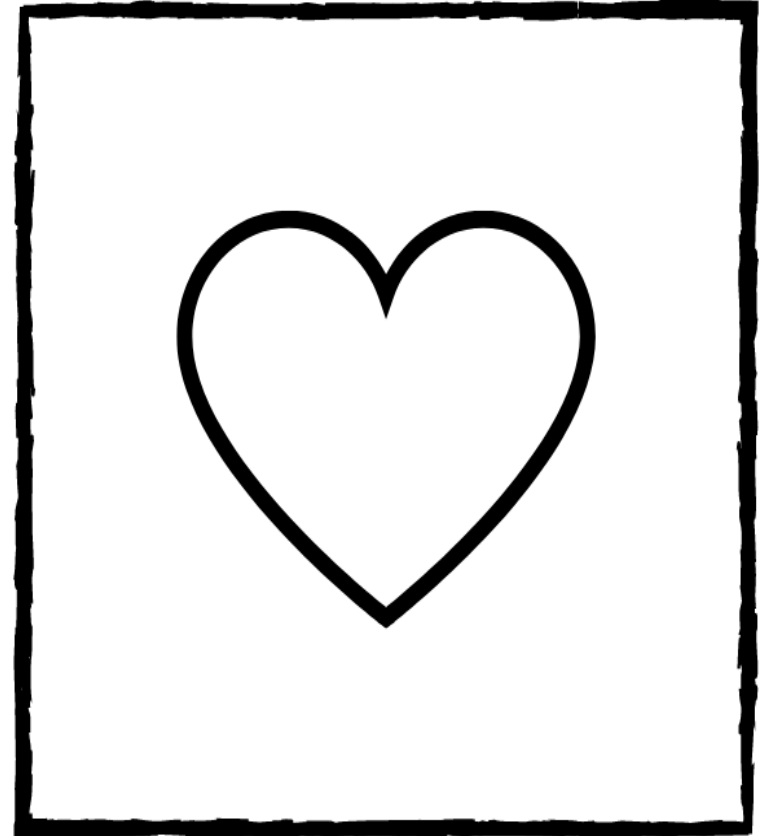

## CONSTITUTION & BY-LAW

### CHANGES

Constitution & By-Law Changes are posted TODAY. These changes will be available for review for 90 days at the welcome desk on Sundays, and in the office during the week. Our plan is to vote on these revisions on September 15<sup>th</sup> at our Fall Kick-off breakfast. We had a lawyer from Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF) review all our documents and policies and provide recommendations. The major changes recommended are that we use the same title and language in both the Constitution and By-Laws concerning our "Statement of Faith". ADF also advised that we revise the phrasing on items such as marriage and the sanctity of human life to better reflect our beliefs. If you have questions, please see an Elder or a Pastor.
