Building News Update

We are seeing progress in multiple areas! You may have noticed that the upstairs bathrooms were reopened on Easter weekend. There is still some detail work to be finished, but they are operational (and beautiful). Take a look at the new flooring! The downstairs bathrooms in the back hallway will soon be taken out of service as we begin demolition of the kitchen. The bathrooms by the church office will still be available. Outside, a large concrete slab has been poured in the front of the building. That concrete forms the base of the floor for our new lobby area. Now that the steel structure is taking shape in the front, you can start to envision what the lobby will look like surrounded by the glass curtain wall. It's going to be gorgeous!

IMPORTANT NOTE: As you make your way into Community Church's parking lot from Route 130, please remember that there is still only ONE entrance into the campus from Route 130. We've always had one entrance, and that has not changed with construction. We've noticed that some people have been entering our campus from Route 130 closer to the Ministry House. That is an EXIT ONLY location, and entering our campus near the Ministry House could cause confusion, traffic congestion or even an accident. As always, we ask that you take your time, pay attention to signs and use extreme caution in the parking lot.
