This week's construction update includes new breaker panels being hooked up; this new electrical service under the current sanctuary (and future youth worship space) will allow our youth to worship without electrical supply concerns. Site work near the future office suite continues, and we are in process of fill (600 loads!) being brought in to bring the land up to grade.

Our parking lot continues to transform; some spaces are added while others are being used for site development. We thank you for your patience during the build, and we covet your prayers as we continue in this process.
