## Connect Guide

### Discuss:

1. Where have you been for an exciting adventure? What location has taught you the most about God and the Bible?
2. What are some Biblical facts many people tend to know? Do you think this information changes someone's life? How does knowledge transform (or not) a person? How does knowledge give us strength, power and influence?
3. Historically, what do you know about Athens? The missionary Paul visited there, and part of his account is recorded in Acts 17. What can we gain from the Biblical account? What types of gods were the people worshipping? What gods are your neighbors worshipping? What gods are you worshipping?
4. Paul used reason to talk to the people in Athens. How can you use reason with your friends, family and co-workers when sharing the gospel? What does worshipping false gods lead to?
