## Highlights from Bro. Bart!

It will soon be the Week of Prayer for foreign missions, starting November 30th. During this time of Thanksgiving, joint worship, Hanging of the Green and special music, the Week of Prayer can get lost. So, we're starting now!

On September 15, 1887, Lottie penned an open letter to Southern Baptist women pleading for more workers, specifically asking that a week be set aside for prayer and for a special offering to be taken for new missionary appointments. Her letter was published in the Foreign Mission Journal the following December. A year later, in 1888, Women's Missionary Union (WMU) was formed, and a week in December was set aside for praying and offerings. The first goal was \$2,000.00, which would be enough to appoint two new female missionaries. In the end, more than \$3,000 was given, resulting in the appointment of three new missionaries.



The offering was later named in memory of Lottie Moon.
