

## **COVID-19 Procedures for Camp Shamineau**

### **Meal Service**

Hand sanitizer is available at the beginning of the serving lines. Additional seating is available outside and in the lower level of the dining hall.

### **Chapel**

Chapel services are held indoors. Musical worship during chapel will not be discouraged.

### **Cleaning Procedures**

In all of our cleaning processes, the products we use are approved for use in the prevention of the spread of COVID-19. The amount of daily cleaning and sanitization performed has been increased. Every day, each counselor is responsible for cleaning all high-touch surfaces in their cabin.

### **Activities**

All regular camp activities will be open and available for use.

### **Face Coverings**

Staff and guests will not be required to wear a face covering indoors. If a staff member or guest chooses to do so, they will not be discouraged.

### **Vaccinations**

Many of our staff members have been vaccinated for COVID-19. However, we do not require that our staff receive the vaccination.

### **Response to COVID-19 Symptoms**

If a camper displays symptoms of COVID-19 during their stay, they will be immediately sent to the health center. Any camper with major symptoms (A temperature of 100 degrees or greater, vomiting, etc.) will be sent home.

### **Response to Positive Cases of COVID-19**

If a camper tests positive for COVID-19, Camp Shamineau will inform the families of all of the campers in their cabin of the positive test.

### **Disclaimer**

Insofar as we have these policies in place, we cannot guarantee the risk of COVID-19 at Camp Shamineau will be fully eliminated. Instead, these policies are in place to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 as much as possible. We realize that each family has to decide for themselves how comfortable they are in coming into a camp situation.
