The Need

A multi-use facility would help us meet our church mission by:

- › allowing more space for kids, youth and adult ministries on a weekly basis and special events (youth group, Adventure Club, Vacation Bible Camp, larger adult gatherings, etc.)
- › allow a separate space for growing student-led worship
- › offering additional ministry opportunities to the community

An updated sanctuary would allow us to meet our church mission by:

- › taking care of what God has entrusted to us
- › being faithful stewards of our church funds
- › offering a safer building
- › having better sound quality and presentation for services and livestream

More community space in the lobby would allow us to meet our church mission by:

- › offering larger connecting space before and after services
- › welcoming visitors
- › increasing space for ministry communication
- › hosting more community meals, events, classes and small group meeting places

The Process

2014

- › people began to pray and Elders determine a building project is essential to the future of Wayzata Free Church

2015

- › clarity around of scope of project | multi-use, community spaces and sanctuary update
- › professionals retained to assist with design, construction and fundraising
- › committees organized (including: executive, building, design and use, capital campaign)
- › conceptual designs shared with congregation
- › congregation votes to proceed (December)

2016

- › advance commitment teams identified and trained
- › congregation kept updated on project plans, vision, fundraising, process
- › educational home visits (February-April)
- › congregation learns advance commitment totals (April 24 celebration)
- › congregation learns final fundraising totals and Elders decision about proceeding (May)
- › members vote (May)

The Timing/Milestones

- › Fall/Winter 2016 – break ground for multi-use facility
- › Summer 2017 – begin Sanctuary remodel
- › Summer/Fall 2017 – begin community space renovation
- › Winter 2017 – project completion

“No decisions can be made, at this time, as to the exact nature of building/renovation projects until we know how much money has been committed through the campaign. We believe the results of the campaign will be one way God is revealing to us how much of this plan He desires for us to do at that time, whether all or part. When the campaign results are in, sometime after the Celebration Event (April 24), Elders/Church leadership will bring a specific recommendation to the congregation for approval.”
