

DWIGHT AND JOSEPHINE ALBRIGHT



Dwight and Josephine Albright first went to Japan in 1969 as students at Harding College. At that time, they committed to help spread the Good News in Japan. They returned to Japan in 1977 with two children (3 years and 1 year) under the oversight of the Park Avenue church of Christ in Memphis, Tennessee, and the support of several other congregations and individuals. After a little over two years in language study, they worked with the Uenohara congregation in Yamanashi Prefecture for a little over six years. Upon their return to the U.S. in 1986, they continued their work with the Park Avenue congregation and maintained their interest in Japan. Since that time, they have made over 35 trips to Japan to encourage Christians, teach, and fill in for missionaries on home leave. When not in Japan, they maintain contact with Christians in Japan and provide information for those interested in going to Japan as missionaries or for visits. The Pineville church of Christ is Dwight's home congregation. He and his parents were baptized there in September 1962. The church supported Dwight and Josephine's ministry while they ministered full-time in Japan. Since returning, the church continues to help with their annual ministry trips
