As part of the CCS 20/20 Vision, beginning in the fall of 2017, CCS began offering an Elementary Homeschool Extension Program. This program allows homeschool students to experience and engage in a variety of on-campus classes and extra-curricular activities with other CCS students. The goal of CCS is to provide families who choose to homeschool the following opportunities:

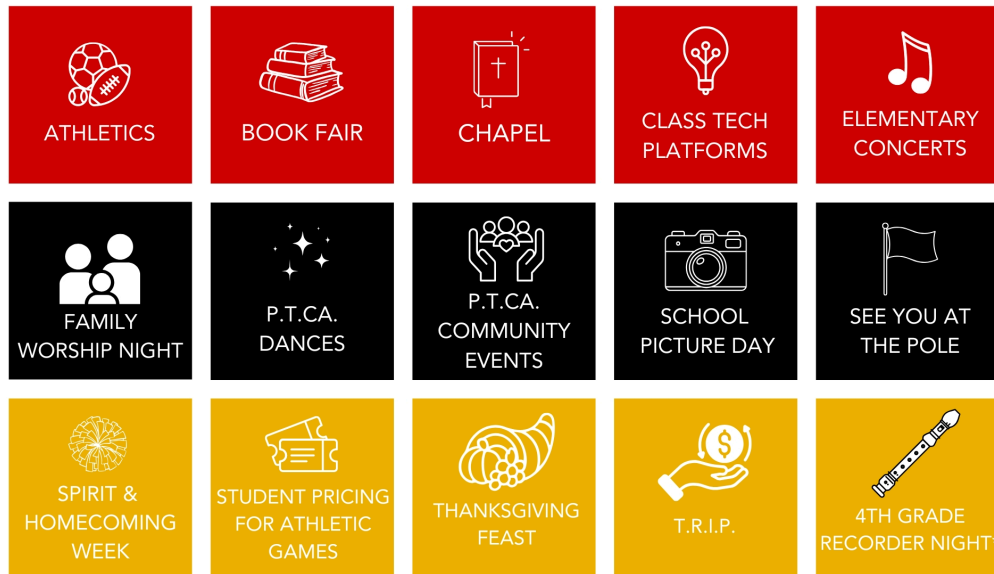
- *to provide your child with a structured, but flexible quality Christian education*
- *to pick and choose what special classes work for their family and their child’s homeschool education*
- *participate under the umbrella of an ACSI/COGNIA accredited school*
- *to be a part-time CCS student with the option of utilizing own chosen curriculum*

CCS Homeschool Extension Program

Part-Time CCS Elementary Homeschool Extension Student (Grades K-6)

- CCS Application Process for Part-Time HEPS
- Student may utilize own chosen homeschool curriculum. CCS will be notified of curriculum being used.
- All grades are kept by homeschool parent.
- August through May School Schedule.
- CCS Homeschool Coordinator is provided as a resource by email or phone as needed for classes taken at CCS.
- Student will enroll in weekly elementary special classes in which they would like to participate. To participate as in part-time CCS HEP, students must be enrolled in at least one weekly elementary special class below, not including Chapel.
 - Music (Grades K-6; Grades 5-6 – Band/Choir meets multiple times/week)
 - PE (Grades K-6)
 - Chapel (Grades K – 2/Month; 1-6 – Weekly) No Charge for Participation
 - Art (Grades 1-6)
 - Computer (Grades 1-3)
 - Spanish (Grades 1-6)
- Student will be invited to participate in on campus events such as weekly chapels or elementary wide events that may be scheduled throughout the school year (i.e. Veterans Day Program (If enrolled in music.), Thanksgiving Feast, if they are able to attend practice times if needed).
- Students will have the opportunity to participate in elementary sports should there be openings on those teams. The Athletic Director will be able to provide information on availability.
- Students will have the opportunity to perform in elementary music programs if they choose to enroll in CCS elementary music class during the week and can attend additional practices.

- Students are not able to participate in the Awards Day/end of year programs.

Noted CCS HEP Policies:

Grading

- P-T students will receive grades on a quarterly basis from CCS for enrolled specials classes
- Transcripts are kept for all P-T students of specials classes only

Enrollment Process:

- Application to the CCS Homeschool Program will open online on June 15th.
- Application fee is non-refundable.
- A family interview will be scheduled once the application forms are complete.
- Schedule for homeschool program will be processed in accordance with the enclosed student application checklist.
- Student will be notified of acceptance by the CCS Registrar.

Payment:

- Full payment of specials classes is required at acceptance into the homeschool program.
- Payment for specials classes, team activities (i.e. intramurals, extra-curricular teams, field trips) are non-refundable.
- There will be no refund for absenteeism resulting in missed specials classes.

Withdrawal Policy:

- Part-time CCS HEP students withdrawing from the program are required to complete and turn into the office a CCS withdrawal form. A refund for a class is only given if the child does not attend the first day of class in August and a refund is requested. Once a student attends class in August, no refunds are given.

Specials Classes Participation:

- Incoming homeschooling students will be sent an elementary specials schedule in June. They will choose classes from this schedule.
- Families will be notified of their schedule.
- Students will wear the CCS uniform for specials classes.
- Students will follow the classroom protocol while participating in specials classes.
- Students will sign in and out at the school office when attending their specials classes.
- Parents are given the school calendar and asked to note days off and half-days.
- Students/parents will be notified by email or phone of any specials class changes or unscheduled school closings.
- Schoolwide emails, news media and/or social media is used for weather related school closings.
