## 2018-2019 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROFILE

### LOCATION

Calvary Christian School, a ministry of Calvary Baptist Church has been providing quality Christian education since 1974. CCS's 63 acre campus is located on Taylor Mill Rd. about 4 miles south of the I-275 loop. Students come from Neighboring Kentucky counties, S.W. Ohio and S.E. Indiana.

### FACILITY

The campus houses the preschool, elementary, middle and high schools. It includes a library, a gymnasium, two computer labs, a cafeteria, 2 soccer fields, 2 baseball fields and a playground. There are two entrances to the school property: one off of Taylor Mill Road and one off of Hands Pike. The school has three parking lots. A separate preschool school house is on the property.

### SCHOOL SYSTEM

Calvary Christian School has students in grade Pre K3 – 12. Total enrollment is approximately 400 with about 200 of those being elementary students. Approximately 56 faculty and staff, spread out over three divisions: elementary school (K3-6) middle school (7-8) and high school (9-12). All Faculty members have at least a bachelor's degree and are ACSI certified; over half have earned a Master's degree.
