Warming Up

1. King Nebuchadnezzar's Babylon was a culture filled with idolatry, paganism, and the like. What are some ways that our culture mimics the culture of Babylon?

2. Read Colossians 3:5 and Galatians 5:19-21. Based on these 2 passages would you categorize our culture as being idolatrous? Explain.
3. Christ followers tend to lose influence in a pagan culture? Why is that?
4. Based on Daniel 2:14-19, What can we learn from the examples of Daniel and his friends about living in a culture that can, at times, be hostile towards our faith?
5. Have you ever had a disturbing dream that you shook you to your core?

6. Kevin said that "People have a tendency to surround themselves with people who tell them what they want to hear? Do you agree with that? Why do you think we do that? Have you noticed that tendency in your own life?"
7. Read Micah 6:8. In our culture, like Nebuchadnezzar's, people are having encounters with life and truth. How can we, in these moments, bring spiritual reasoning and be a voice of reason and truth?
8. As Christ followers, how can we live in order to gain people's trust in order for them to consider and seek after our wisdom and insight?
