Privileges	Responsibilities
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forgiven— (Ephesians 1:7): “In Him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace” 2. Made Righteous—(2 Corinthians 5:21): “God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.” 3. Salvation by grace alone, in Christ alone (Ephesians 2:8-9; Philippians 2:13; Hebrews 13:21; Galatians 2:20) 4. Granted right to sit together with Christ in Heavenly places – (Ephesians 2:60): “And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus” 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No longer to live in sin (Romans 6:1-3; 1 John 3:9-10) 2. Commanded to be holy— (1 Thessalonians 4:7): “For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life” 3. Commanded to “work out” our own salvation— (Philippians 2:12): “Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed--not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence--continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling” 4. Commanded to “put on the whole armor of God” here in faith so that we can withstand any evil day. (Ephesians 6:11,13) “Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes.” <p><i>Salvation produces internal results with external impact (people, places, circumstances)</i></p>
