2020 White Box Lenten Campaign

Water of Life

One of the three traditional observances of Lent is almsgiving. By giving alms, our material fasting - what we give up for Lent - not only helps us but it helps others. For the last three years, Sacred Heart has built three chapels through our Lenten White Box Campaign.

Last year we built a chapel/community center in Independencia, Bolivia. Now that the chapel/community center is fully operational, we want to provide the community that live in the area with drinking water. Around 1,000 will benefit from this water project.

Technically, the project consists in capturing water from a natural spring up in the mountain, building a water catchment, structure, and developing a pipe system to take the water down to the chapel/center some 5 miles away.

Our goal is to raise \$20,000 for this project. Because we are immersed in the Love One another Capital Campaign, we will be aiming at a lower goal than the previous White Box Campaigns.
