HUMAN CONCERNS - June Outreach Project

The June Outreach Project was for St. Francis Solanus Indian Mission School which received a \$300.00 grant. The school is located in Stone Lake, WI and is operated by the School Sisters of St. Francis. It is the only Catholic School in Sawyer County and was built for the purpose of Catholic Indian Education with enrollment usually around 100 to 120 students. It is a tuition free school for pre-school through 8th grade and exists primarily through donations. Outreach is just one of the many Human Concerns activities at Sacred Heart.
