



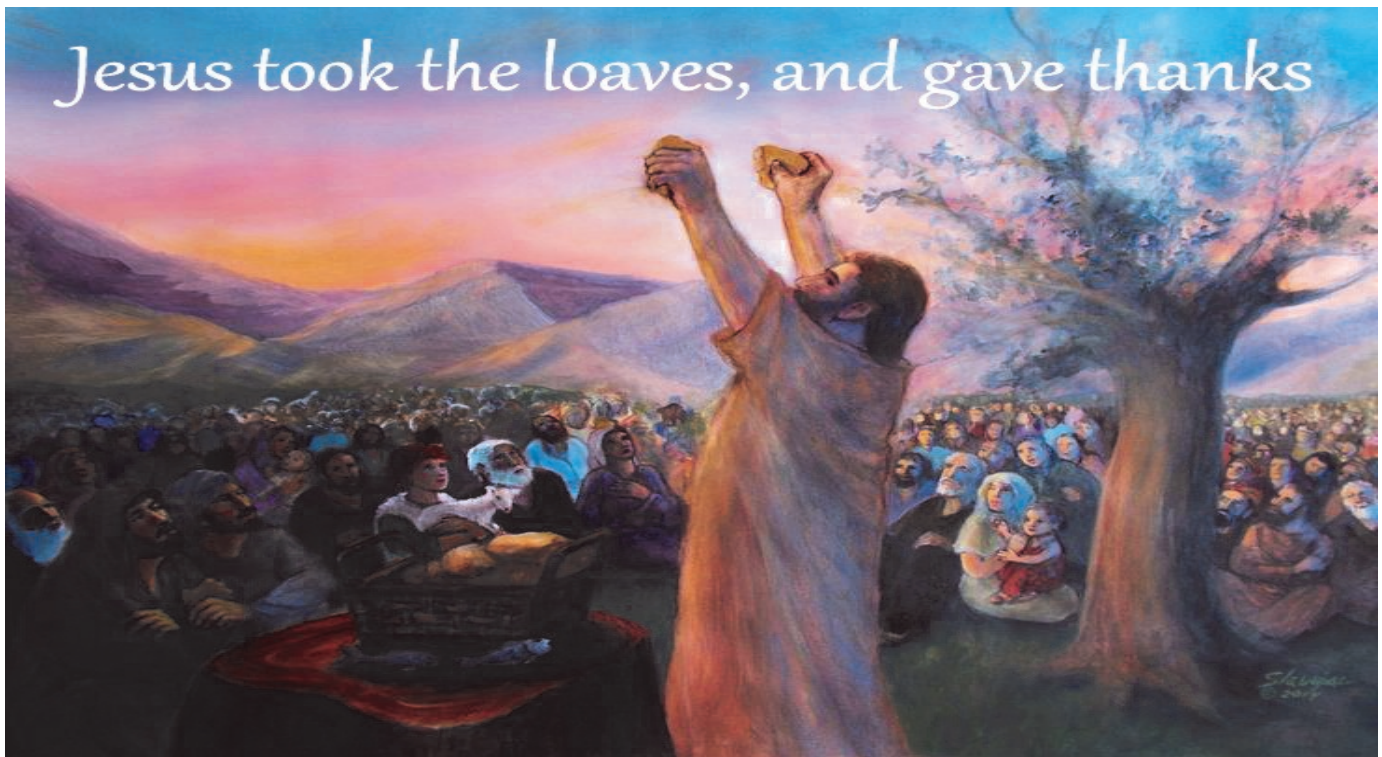

A.C.T.S. PRAYER GROUP

The A.C.T.S. Prayer Group is made up of parishioners who have volunteered to serve our parish in a prayer ministry. There are also three cloistered convents of nuns in our prayer group. The group will pray for your special prayer requests. The name A.C.T.S. represents four types of prayer:
