



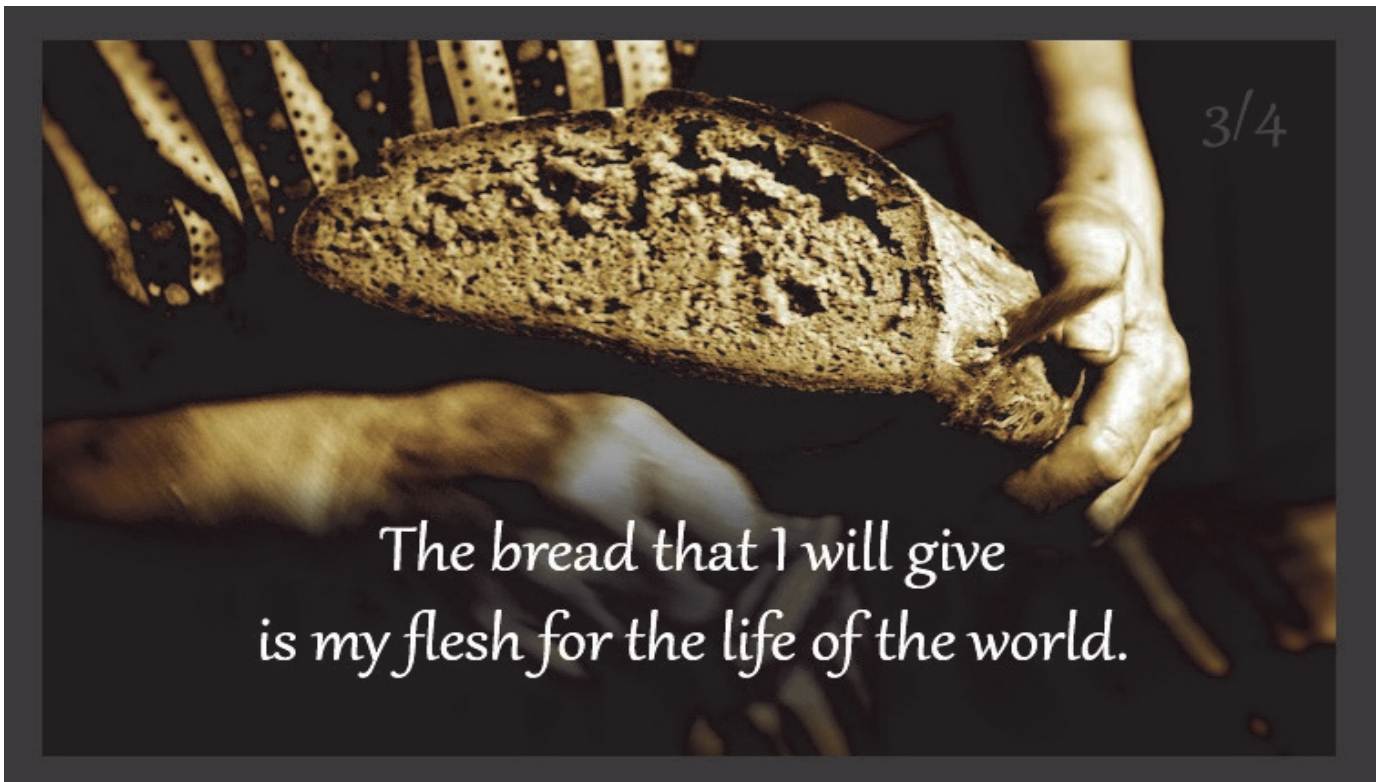

**HUMAN TRAFFICKING**

Vulnerable individuals become victims because they don't feel loved. Those at risk: children from broken homes, run-aways, history of abuse; disconnected or isolated; mentally or physically disabled; in child welfare & justice system; drug abuse. Perpetrators notice vulnerability & start grooming victims within 2-4 months. Initially, many men take advantage of the victim; this is videotaped & the person is shown the video. The man threatens to kill the girl's mother if she doesn't cooperate. 99% will succumb to threats. Victims don't see possibility of redemption.

In emergencies, we assist with furniture, household items or clothing. We work collaborative with other service agencies like Human Services to suggest resources for work, education or budgeting.
