Congratulations to all! We have now reached 125% of our goal or \$868,325—and this with only 107 families participating. Any pledges we receive from now going forward will be 100% for the parish. Finance Council is having its monthly meeting and we will begin to plan on how and when to execute the different projects. As you know, our parish case consists of starting a fund for major repairs, upgrading the church itself, remodeling the basement for a Faith Formation space, and creating an endowment-type fund for those most in need. Any pledge, big or small, helps. We thank those who have pledged, and we want to encourage those who still have not.
