

I was born in St. Louis, the third of nine kids (3b,lg,lb,4g), after moving around a bit (St. Petersburg, FL and Hillsborough, NC), we settled in Wisconsin in 2007 (first Franklin, then New Berlin). My Mom homeschooled all of us, and my Dad is a systems librarian at Marquette University. The Catholic faith has always been the most important feature of our life as a family.

Starting in high school, one of the most important parts of my life was the Schoenstatt movement. I graduated in 2017 with my degree in computational mathematics, but rather than enter grad school right away, I decided to seek good habits (specifically habits of prayer) by offering a year as a campus missionary with Brew City Catholic. This was possibly the best decision I've ever made.

After praying consistently for a number of months, the Lord put it on my heart to reconsider the priesthood. He had been teaching me about myself for quite some time in a variety of ways, such as formation sessions with the missionaries or the Called and Gifted seminar. To make a long story very short, I realized that if it were up to me, I would become a priest, and decided to apply to seminary. I was accepted and began in the fall of 2018, and was ordained on May 17, 2025. One of the things I've learned a lot from being a missionary and going through seminary is the importance of healing
