John & Amanda Herrick: (serving in Ireland with Biblical Ministries Worldwide) Depression and suicide is at an epidemic here. At times we feel inadequate to help, but we do have the answer for Hope. Please pray for wisdom as we talk with people who are suffering in so many ways. Leah's visa is finally fixed for a year! Thank you for your continued prayers for her. Now that Leah has her visa we will be leaving for China. This has been a busy week getting our visas for China and packing. We are so thankful for this opportunity to visit Leah and see what she is involved in. This month at the church is our Missions Month with various visiting missionaries. Pray for hearts to be challenged to serve here amongst the Irish and other places. This past Sunday we had our college students over for dinner. This time the students cooked for us their authentic Chinese and Malaysian dishes. Brian Tan shared the Word, and he used some of the symbols in Chinese to explain the Gospel. We had 5 new Chinese students that have never been. Please pray for these students, that the Christian students who see them on a daily basis will have opportunities to follow up & continue to befriend them, for salvation and that they take the Gospel back to their home country. I read this week: “Do you feel inadequate, weak, and overwhelmed with this task? If so, then that's right where God needs you to be in order to use you. Open your hands, your heart, your plans.
