

Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need to have anything written to you. 2 For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. 3 While people are saying, “There is peace and security,” then sudden destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape. 4 But you are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief. 5 For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness. 6 So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober. 7 For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, are drunk at night. 8 But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. 9 For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, 10 who died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with him.

MISSIONARY UPDATE

John & Amanda Herrick (serving with Biblical Ministries Worldwide – Ireland)
We have had a college ministry with the students from the local institute. A couple of weeks ago a few of them came to us asking if it was possible to have a study started at their accommodation in town. Without hesitation we said Yes! We have encouraged them to make this a student-run study. They are organizing worship, games and snacks and John will be responsible for the teaching time. The students have a fantastic enthusiasm and great love and passion for seeing classmates who don’t know Christ hear the gospel. We meet every second Friday evening with one study focusing on discipleship, the second will be an evangelistic study. We are so thankful to the Lord to reach out to these students. One of the students told us there may be a smaller group, if any at all, next year because it will be cheaper for the students to go to England than to come to Ireland. Ireland is now one of the most expensive countries in Europe. Housing is expensive for the students. God has given us these students for now and we want to love them! Pray we won’t waste this opportunity and that we can show and share the love of Christ to this fantastic group of students. We are still waiting on John’s approval from immigration for Irish citizenship. Pray this comes through soon so we can start making plans for a furlough.
