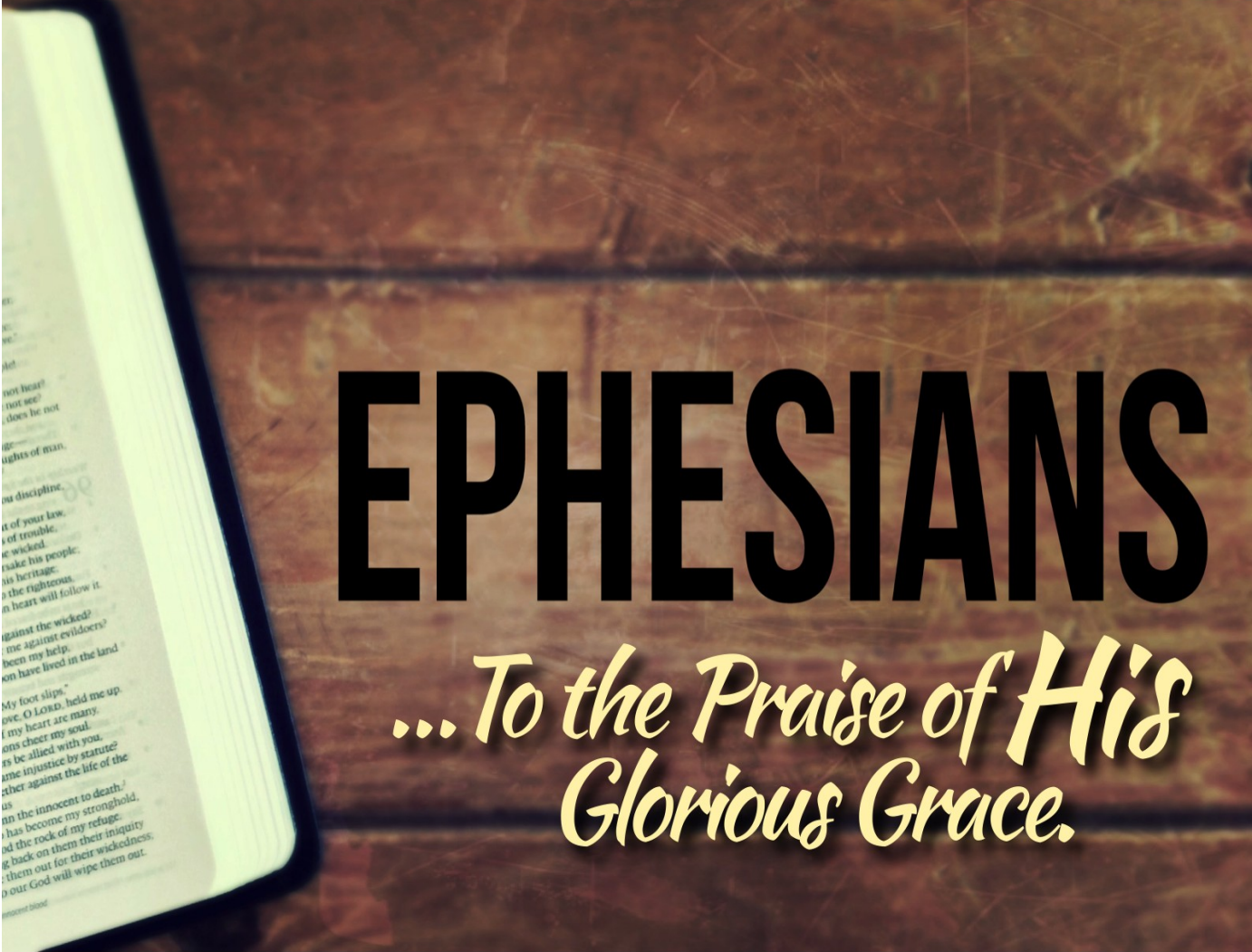

MISSIONARY UPDATE

Jen Kierstead: (PACA Worldventure – Brazil)
Praise! A new school year is off and running. Students and new teachers have transitioned and are doing well. Praise! Radiation finished on August 16. I will have a follow up appointment with the radiation doctor on September 11. My skin is healing nicely. Please pray for me during the next two weeks of rest (post radiation and pre-oral chemo). I was in the ER last week due to respiratory infection. Pray for my body to fight off the germs and stay healthy for this next round of treatment. Oral chemo will start on September 13. Pray for wisdom for my doctors, for me and for God’s healing in my life. It is not what I would have planned but I know God has a purpose in it. He doesn’t make mistakes and uses it in my story. Pray for what the next steps will be. I plan to leave PACA to return to the U.S. to spend time with family (not sure of when but working with the school, mission and insurance). I am in the midst of looking for a job and what God has for me next.
