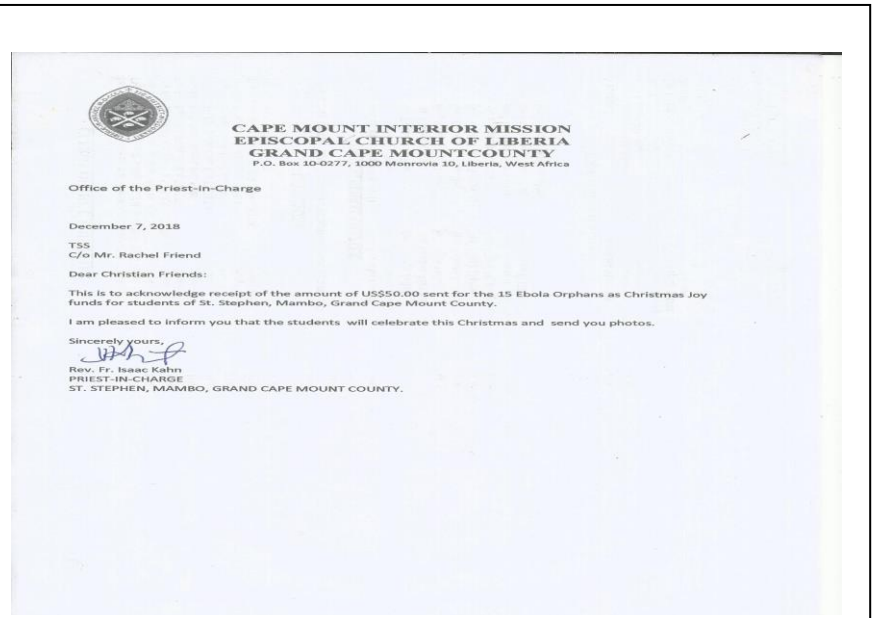


Meet our 2 new students!
