


The cost is \$195 per student, and we want every student to be able to attend, so scholarships are available if needed. You can pay by cash, check, or online. Register online by

Two donors gave two units of red blood cells during the blood drive using a special automated machine. This process, called apheresis, separates and collects the red cells, then safely returns the remaining blood components and saline to the donor. Power Red donations are particularly beneficial for donors with O+, O-, A-, or B- blood types, which are in high demand.
