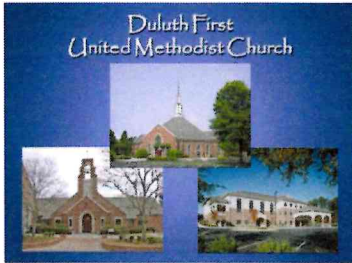

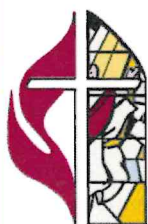


Two donors gave two units of red blood cells during the blood drive using a special automated machine. This process, called apheresis, separates and collects the red cells, then safely returns the remaining blood components and saline to the donor.
