



An American Red Cross Blood Drive will be held at Duluth First UMC on Wednesday, November 12<sup>th</sup>, from 3 to 7 p.m. in the Dorothy L. Rainey Fellowship Hall. To schedule an appointment to make a blood donation:

### **Grow One Step Chart**

Many folks have found the **Grow One Step** chart helpful for their giving. Most of us know it's best for us to put God first and to

move toward tithing (giving God the first 10% of our income). But we find it hard to get started. That's where the chart comes in.

Over a decade ago, a young couple I know with two school-aged daughters wanted to tithe. They were giving, but they didn't know what percentage of their income they were giving.

The grid side of the enclosed chart showed them that they were giving 2%. They decided to grow one step by giving 3% the next year. That worked, and they kept going – the following year – 4%, then 5%, etc. After eight years they were tithing, giving God 10%. They are happy to be continuing that practice today as their daughters graduate from college.

We understand the holiday season may be a challenge for individuals and families who have lost someone special. Duluth First UMC has established a meaningful time for people


to come together...to reflect, to remember and to honor those lives that have meant so much.

in order to grow one step each year until you are tithing.


