



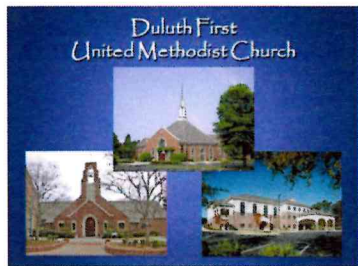

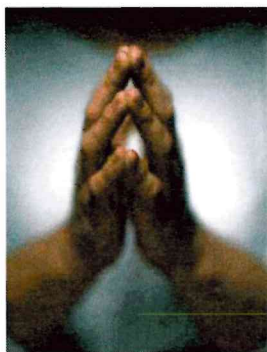

Founded in 2008, **Street Grace** been chasing one ambitious vision - **ending the sexual exploitation of children**. Street Grace works on four areas to make changes:

- **PREVENTION** to help all of us recognize and stop exploitation before it starts;
- **PROTECTION** to make survival sustainable;

- **POLICY** which makes safety the standard, shapes laws, training and systems that protect children long before a crisis begins.

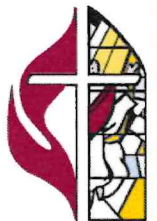
