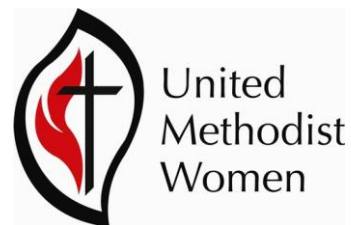

February 11, "Building the Beloved Community"

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr's prescription for a healthy society was based on justice, equality, and love. How do we apply those ideals to today's fractured and fearful world in order to build the community that Dr. King envisioned?

Speaker: Dr. Marvin McMickle is President of Colgate Rochester Crozer Divinity School in Rochester, New York, and Professor of African American Religious Studies.

February 18, "Racial Healing: An Inner and Outer Journey"

The essence of healing our racial divisions comes from transformation of our inner thoughts, conscious and unconscious, and our outward actions. How do we build mutually respectful and healthy relationships across racial and ethnic lines?

Speaker: Dr. Catherine Meeks identifies herself as an author, racial healing consultant, and midwife to the soul, and is currently Director of the Absalom Jones Center for Racial Healing in Atlanta, Georgia.

February 25, "What We Believe Matters: A Bonhoeffer Moment"

Dietrich Bonhoeffer, a German pastor, bravely spoke truth to power in resisting Nazism and was eventually executed for his actions. What does Bonhoeffer's life teach us today about speaking out against injustice and acting on our beliefs?

Speaker: Dr. Lori Brandt Hale is an Associate Professor of Religion at Augsburg University, Minneapolis, Minnesota, and a scholar of the work and thought of Nazi resister Dietrich Bonhoeffer.

The 2019 John Clay Memorial CROP Hunger Walk will be held on Sunday February 24 at 3 PM.

CROP Hunger Walks are interfaith hunger education and fundraising events sponsored by the Church World Services (CWS). Organized by local churches and community organizations that are led by volunteers, to raise funds for food, clean water, and provide resources (such as seeds, tools, technical training etc.) that empower people to meet their own needs. Donations raised are sent to the most impoverished nations as well as used locally to eradicate hunger.

CROP Hunger Walks take place throughout the year across the US. The Venice John Clay Memorial CROP Hunger Walk is often the most successful in Florida and is usually one of the top fund raisers in the nation.
