August - Week One

SUNDAY: August 7th

Scripture: 1 Samuel 3:10 And the LORD came and called as before, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel replied, "Speak, your servant is listening."

Suggested Prayer: LORD, as I listen for your voice during this time of prayer and fasting, help me help our family of God at Wolfforth UMC during this transitional time in the denomination. LORD, as your servant help me listen to you. Amen.

MONDAY: August 8th

Scripture: Psalm 111:10 Fear of the LORD is the foundation of true wisdom. All who obey his commandments will grow in wisdom. Praise him forever! Suggested Prayer: LORD, as your servant and one who lives with the fear of the LORD, I seek your true wisdom. LORD, I need your wisdom in this critical time in the life of our church. I want to be obedient to your commandments and grow in your wisdom. LORD, my desire is to praise you and glorify you in all I do forever. Amen.

TUESDAY: August 9th

Scripture: Proverbs 1:2-3, 5, 7 Their purpose is to teach people wisdom and discipline, to help them understand the insights of the wise. 3 Their purpose is to teach people to live disciplined and successful lives, to help them do what is right, just, and fair. 5 Let the wise listen to these proverbs and become even wiser. Let those with understanding receive guidance. 7 Fear of the LORD is the foundation of true knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.

Suggested Prayer: LORD, I know your commandments teach me wisdom and discipline which allows me to have insight into the information presented.

This allows me to do what is right, just, and fair. As I listen to YOU may I have understanding and receive guidance and true knowledge. LORD, you are the foundation of true knowledge. LORD, give me your wisdom in this situation. Amen.

WEDNESDAY: August 10th

Scripture: James 3:17-18 But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and the fruit of good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere. 18 And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

Suggested Prayer: LORD, I know the wisdom from you is pure. Your wisdom allows me to be peace loving, gentle at all times, and full of mercy. Your pure wisdom shows no favoritism. LORD, I ask you to give me the character of your pure wisdom as the information meetings are presented and some people may have difficulties understanding. LORD, allow me to be a peacemaker and plant seeds of peace. Amen.

THURSDAY: August 11th

Scripture: 1 John 5:21 Dear children, keep away from anything that might take God's place in your hearts.

Suggested Prayer: LORD, help me keep my focus on you, especially in this time of prayer and fasting, to decern the direction our church is to take during this time of transition of the denomination. Amen.

FRIDAY: August 12th

Scripture John 15:12 This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you.

Suggested Prayer: LORD, help me to LOVE those who don't agree with me as you LOVE me when I am unlovable. Amen.

SATURDAY: August 13th

Scripture Joshua 22:5 But be very careful to obey all the commands and the instructions that Moses gave to you. Love the LORD your God, walk in all his ways, obey his commands, hold firmly to him, and serve him with all your heart and all your soul
