August - Week Four

MONDAY: August 29th

Scripture: John 15:12-15 This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you. There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command. I no longer call you slaves, because a master doesn't confide in his slaves. Now you are my friends, since I have told you everything the Father told me.

Suggested Prayer: LORD, you have called me friend when I do what you have commanded me to do. I am no longer a slave. I am your friend since you, Jesus have told me everything the Father told you. Therefore, I can LOVE others as Jesus has LOVED me. Amen.

TUESDAY: August 30th

Scripture: Psalm 63:1-4 O God, you are my God; I earnestly search for you. My soul thirsts for you; my whole body longs for you in this parched and weary land where there is no water. I have seen you in your sanctuary and gazed upon your power and glory. Your unfailing love is better than life itself; how I praise you! I will praise you as long as I live, lifting up my hands to you in prayer.

Suggested Prayer: LORD, more than anything I search for you and long to drink from your fountain of living water. I have seen your power, and your glory. I know your unfailing LOVE is better than anything. I PRAISE YOU! I will praise you forever lifting my hands to you in prayer. Amen.

WEDNESDAY: August 31st

Scripture: Colossians 1:9-14 So we have not stopped praying for you since we first heard about you. Then the way you live will always honor and please the Lord, and your lives will produce every kind of good fruit. All the while, you will grow as you learn to know God better and better. THURSDAY: September 1st
