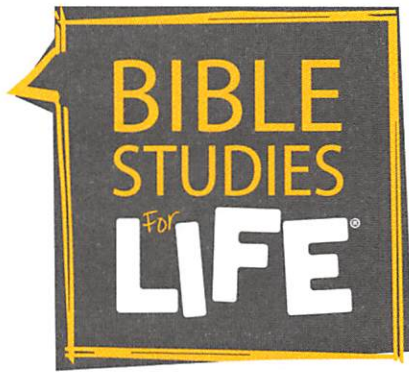

JESUS CHOSE TWELVE HELPERS

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 10:1-14

WEEKLY VERSE: Jesus chose men to help Him. *Mark 3:14*

LIFE POINT: People can help others know about God.

Jesus chose twelve men to be His disciples (helpers). These men had a special job to do. The twelve men that Jesus chose were Peter and his brother, Andrew; James and his brother, John; Philip; Bartholomew; Thomas; Matthew; another man named James; Thaddaeus; Simon; and Judas.

Jesus taught the disciples what to do and how to help Him. Jesus wanted them to travel to towns and tell people about God. Jesus told the disciples to help people who were sick.

Jesus told the disciples, "Do not take money, extra food, or clothes with you when you travel. Someone in the town you go to will invite you to stay in his house. Stay there until you leave town. Some towns may not want you to help them. Leave that town and go to another one."

The disciples went out and did what Jesus had told them.
