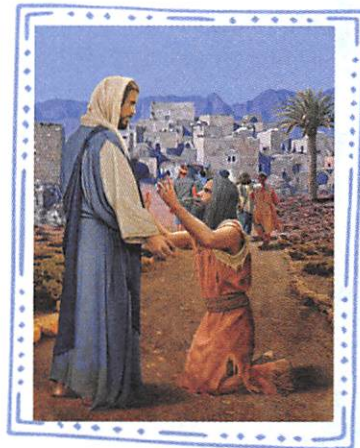
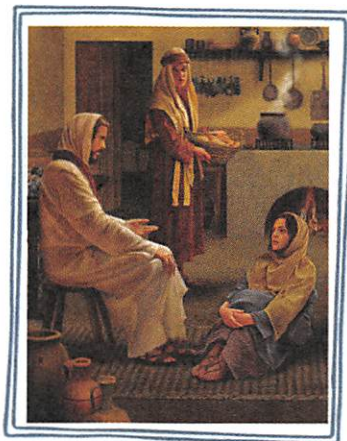
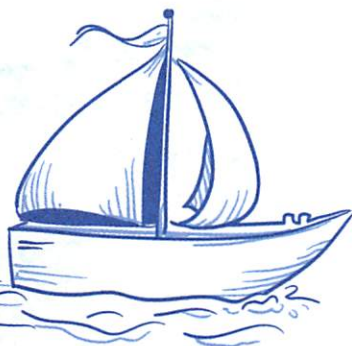
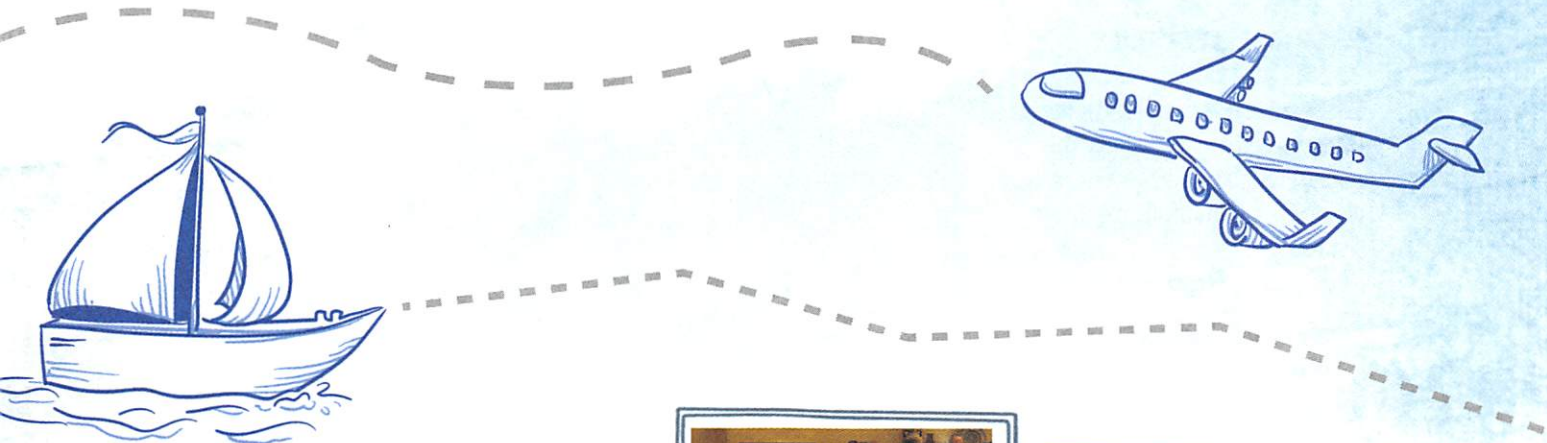
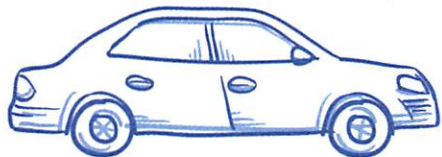


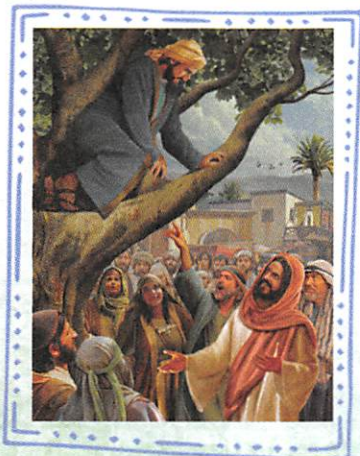
Trace and Tell

PAUL'S FIRST JOURNEY

SCRIPTURE: Acts 13

WEEKLY VERSE: Tell everyone about Jesus. *Matthew 28:19-20*

LIFE POINT: People can tell about Jesus.

Paul and Barnabas were teachers in the church at Antioch. God wanted them to go to many places and tell people about Jesus. The men in the church prayed for Paul and Barnabas before they left. The church sent them out as missionaries.

They sailed to an island called Cyprus. They taught about Jesus in the synagogues (churches). Then they sailed from the island and went to many other places. Everywhere they went, they told the people about God and that Jesus was God's Son. Many people wanted to hear more about Jesus.

In one town, Paul taught about Jesus in the synagogue. The people asked Paul and Barnabas to come back the next week and teach them more about Jesus. A large crowd came to hear what Paul would say. Some of the people believed that Jesus was God's Son; other people did not believe.

Paul and Barnabas continued to tell people about Jesus in many different places.
