**SCRIPTURE:** Luke 19:1-10

**WEEKLY VERSE:** Jesus said, "I love you." *John 15:9*

**LIFE POINT:** Jesus loves all people.

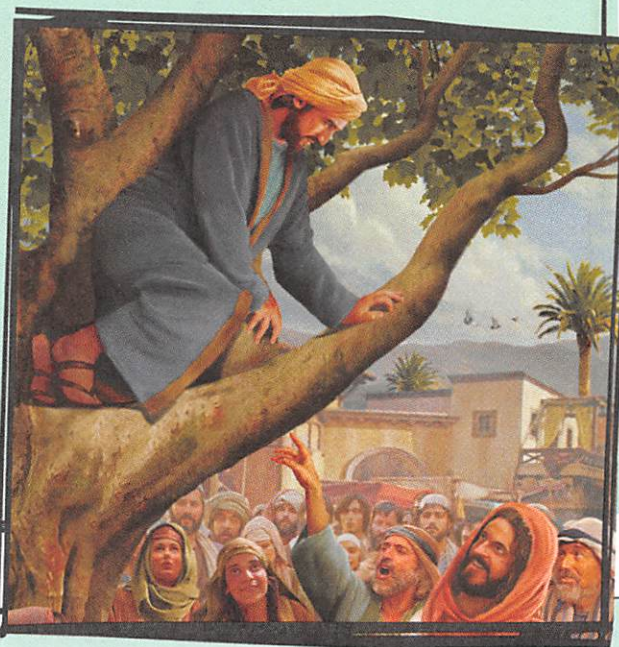
