Where is camp held/Contact info?

- Euroventure is held at the [Downtown Lodge \(DTL\) in Grindelwald, Switzerland](#). DTL is a village of 5 lodges. Three completely equipped lodges with a total of 185 beds are rented as group houses. In the two other lodges there are a total of 92 beds. Right in the heart of Grindelwald, DTL is the right accommodation for groups of up to 290 persons. The Lodge is the best starting point for hiking areas of the breath-taking landscape around the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau. Right around the corner, you will find many restaurants and shops.

What will I need to pay for while there?

- Everything is included for the week so your student should have no general expenses. There are several stores near the camp for snacks and souvenirs plus additional recreational costs including miniature golf, tobogganing, and ice skating. Prices vary.

- In the past few years as electronic communication has increased, we have noticed more cell phones and ipods at camp. This year we would like to offer a week without the distractions of electronics. We will ask the adult leaders to lock up the devices during the week. They may use them on the bus ride to and from. (At the camp leaders discretion.)
