Eventually, a wise, seasoned CNA told her to put the pictures away. Her presence and love during the time they were together was enough. She did, and, not only her job, but her life became smoother and more joyful.

We are not called to save people from depression or addiction. We are called to help as we are able, but not take responsibility for the one we are helping. As we continue through Lent may we care for ourselves as we care for others.
