# From the desk of the DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT

#### Dear Canada West District family,

I was recently travelling along Highway 40, after a day of worship with Revs. Bernice McNair, Sheldon Hirschfeld, and the wonderful people of Open Door Community Church of the Nazarene in Prince Alberta, Saskatchewan. I was reflecting on the many stories shared by our people who were living life with those in their community – advocating for housing, journeying with others through health crises, providing food and clothing, engaging with Indigenous leaders and learning alongside loved ones about their culture and their history, offering companionship where there is isolation, interceding in prayer for people in palliative care.

This beautiful group of Nazarenes is a living example of the second half of the Gospel, found in 1 John 3:16:

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.

Why is this text the banner for the second half of the gospel? Because it clearly and profoundly defines what God means by love, the ongoing process of abandoning one's life to Jesus Christ in love for the sake of others coming to know him. It is the movement from believing the love of God in Jesus Christ to becoming the love of God in Jesus Christ.\*

Nothing is more beautiful, winsome, or powerful than people laying down their interests, agendas, needs, and desires for the best interests of others. In fact, the most descriptive word for this kind of love is holy.\* (from Wake-Up Call, May 16, 2025, by JD Walt)

Our day with Daryl Cripe at District Reunion 2025 was a compelling invitation for the second half of the Gospel. We have 26 people committed to beginning to Engage with those around them. Another 54 cards had names of 'Ones' that are being loved with a 'holy love'. Those cards had over 173 names (some names were listed as an entire family). There are also 119 names written on the painting by Matt Austin, after our time with Rev. Ryan Nelson. These people are ever before us. I am praying, along with you, for their hearts to turn to Christ.

May God stir the embers once again within us, Canada West District, that we would be moved from warm complacency to becoming the love of God in Jesus Christ.




## SEDGEWICK COMMUNITY CHURCH (AB)

#### FIRST CHURCH CALGARY (AB)





## **IN MEMORY**




