From the desk of the DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT

Dear Canada West District family,

IOne of my favourite nephews (they are all favourites!) is currently working for a company that harvests seeds from an endangered species tree. The goal is to get to the seeds before the birds. I am not sure why, but the trees are not germinating through the spread of the birds. So the company will plant the seeds and help the species recover to its former glory.

I don't know who discovered the endangered status of these trees. I am thrilled to hear that there are people doing something to help them flourish once again.

This illustration readily brings to mind the following verses: And he told them many things in parables, saying: "A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seeds fell along the path, and the birds came and devoured them. Other seeds fell on rocky ground, where they did not have much soil, and immediately they sprang up, since they had no depth of soil, but when the sun rose they were scorched. And since they had no root, they withered away. Other seeds fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked them. Other seeds fell on good soil and produced grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. He who has ears, let him hear." (Matthew 13:3-9 ESV)

My nephew has been tasked with finding the seeds to sow. He isn't gathering soil, or sunshine, or mountain water. He is looking for the seeds. This parable of Scripture is troublesome for people who think the sower should become more efficient and stop wasting the seed on tough terrain. Yet J.D. Walt in his devotional Seedbed, states that this misses the point entirely. "The rule of the kingdom is not efficiency. It is extravagance—sowing seeds everywhere all the time. The kingdom we seek is not about the soil. It's not about the sower. It's about the Seed. And the Seed is the Word of God—who is the Son of God—flourishing in the soil of you. '

This edition of the Loop shows the extravagant ways the Son of God is being spread throughout our district.

Go and be extravagant, sharing the Son of God everywhere you go! May God's Kingdom flourish in each of our communities.






DID YOU KNOW???


